

Extended abstract submission due has been extended to November 15, 2022.

**The 9th International Conference on Flood Management (ICFM9) on
“River Basin Disaster Resilience and Sustainability by All
- Integrated Flood Management in the Post COVID-19 Era”**

Dear Lead Authors,

After the discussions between the International Association of Hydrological Sciences (IAHS) and the ICFM9 Secretariat, we have decided to postpone the manuscript submission to the Proceedings of IAHS (PIAHS) until after the conference because we want all the "extended abstracts" to be shared by as many participants as possible at the conference. Immediately after the conference, we will open the submission for a month and close it at the end of March to complete its publication in September 2023.

Due to this change, we have decided to extend the submission of "extended abstracts" to November 15, 2022. ICFM9 requests all those whose abstract has been accepted and who will make an oral or poster presentation at the conference to submit an extended abstract, in principle. An extended abstract can be submitted to the conference proceedings at the following site:

(The “My Page” site will be open on October 28, 2022.)

The submitted abstracts will be carefully handled by the ICFM9 Secretariat and made digitally available for the conference participants only during ICFM9. If extended abstracts are only meant to be conference materials, their originality does not necessarily matter. However, please note that the originality does matter for them to be eligible for PIAHS.

If you cannot submit an extended abstract for some compelling reasons, such as difficulty in ensuring the originality of your research, please contact the ICFM9 Secretariat by November 15, 2022. Neither oral nor poster presentations will be possible if no extended abstract is submitted or no contact is made with the secretariat. All those planning to make a presentation must complete the registration for the conference by November 15, 2022. The ICFM9 Secretariat will make arrangements for oral and poster presentations based on the list of registered participants. If you need to cancel your participation in the conference, you must contact the ICFM9 Secretariat by November 15, 2022.
